GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS FOR PRESENTATION FOR IAPA 2021 ONLINE CONFERENCE

1. Only Original research papers and retrospective studies are accepted for paper presentations
2. All others can be sent as e Poster presentations (including Audit reports and case reports)
3. Abstracts should not exceed 500 words. Abstracts should be structured (Introduction, Study methodology, Observations& Results , Conclusion) for original papers
4. All Abstracts and E posters should be in PDF form only. **Otherwise it will not be accepted.**
5. The Abstracts and E posters and should have the name of the first author and institute name and place.
6. All papers/ poster should compulsorily have the e mail id and the phone number and designation (Post Graduate Student/Fellowship student/ Faculty/ Pvt. Practitioner) of the presenting author.
7. **The name of the PDF file** (e Poster or Abstract of the Paper) should contain the name of the presenting person for easy identification

(If any of the above guidelines are not followed, the paper/poster may not be accepted.)

8. The posters/ papers are screened and the selected papers are called for presentations.
9. All presentations will be on virtual platform that will be provided by the organizers.

PODIUM PRESENTATIONS

1. Podium presentations are taken two weeks before the conference and selection of the papers are done for final podium presentations.
2. Time for presentation: 8min + 2min for Q&A
3. Type of presentation: The presenter is required to prepare a Power point (windows version XP, 2007) presentation.
4. The date and time slot for presentation in the first week of March. No requests for change in the slot will be entertained.
5. **Selected candidates should do the final presentations again on the day of conference.**

POSTER PRESENTATIONS

1. Poster presentations are taken two weeks before the conference.
2. The presentation of the poster will be on the online platform using power point slides (Maximum 4 Slides)
3. Time for presentation: 4 min + 2min for Q&A
4. The date and time slot for presentation in the first week of March. No requests for change in the slot will be entertained.
