Safe Anaesthesia in Children: An Update

The keynote address was on - Paediatric anaesthesia and sleep disorders. Important lectures concentrating on safety during laparoscopic surgeries, transfusion practices in neonates, changing preoperative fasting guidelines, interpretation of clotting tests in

neonates, evolution of cuffed endotracheal tubes and POCUS in paediatrics were held. CME also had an interesting panel discussion on clinical case-based scenarios. We had an active Pro-Con session on necessity of intravascular access during paediatric anaesthesia. The CME was completed by a Quiz for the postgraduates and trainees which was very interactive and well conducted.





The CME was well organised and ably conducted under the leadership of Dr Gita Nath, Dr Y Ravi Nagaprasad, Dr M Subrahmanyam and the office bearers and executive committee members of IAPA, Telangana. The CME was well attended and appreciated by 140 delegates, both from and outside the state.

It was definitely an academic feast which concentrated on safety issues and commonly encountered practical problems in paediatric anaesthesia.
